At this point in the year, with so much information, I hope that you don't feel that it has been too much. Please do pop and chat to us in the playground in the morning if you have any questions.

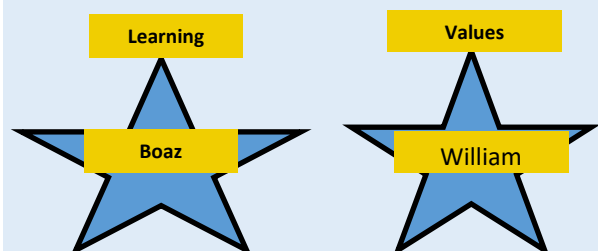
Have a lovely weekend and lets hope the sun shines.

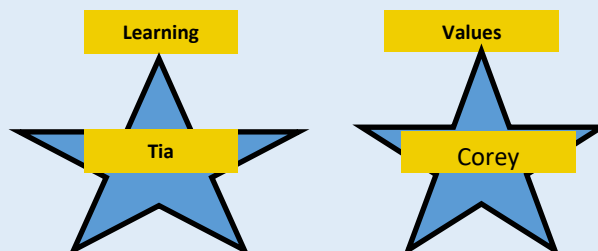
